

Emeriti faculty and retired staff may obtain a retiree identification card which permits them access to specified University benefits and activities. Some of the activities include:

- Continued use of their Truman email (which would include Truman Today)
- Guest parking stickers
- Free use of the Library
- Tuition waiver as outlined in Board of Governors policy
- Copy work at Printing Services at cost
- Notary Public services available in the Business Office
- Use of Natatorium during time period designated for current and retired employees
- Use of Student Recreation Center and participation in ongoing programs
- Eligibility for Designated Guest ID card program where eligible dependents may receive an ID card granting privileges similar to retirees but on a more restricted basis
- If under the age of 65, options for continued medical, dental and vision through COBRA and conversion of life insurance to a “term” policy with the retiree paying the premium

All will receive a Presidential Guest Pass which allows admittance into most University sponsored events with the exception of Lyceum and SAB events which require a separate ticket.

The President’s Office, in conjunction with the Office of Advancement, invite all emeriti and retired staff to the annual Emeriti and Retired Staff Dinner. Local emeriti faculty members and retired staff are also invited to the annual Faculty and Staff Holiday Open House hosted by the President.

In addition, all will receive the Truman Review. They also receive relevant alumni and advancement contact via email or mailings on an individual basis depending on their preferences and updates with the Office of Advancement.

Mailing address databases for all emeriti faculty members and retired staff are maintained in the President’s Office, with updates provided to the Offices of Advancement and Human Resources.
