

Emeriti faculty and retired staff may obtain a retiree identification card, which permits them to access specified University benefits and activities. Some of the activities include:

- Guest parking sticker.
- Free use of the Library.
- Tuition waiver as outlined in Board of Governors policy.
- Copy work at Printing Services at cost.
- Notary Public services available in the Business Office.
- Admittance into all regular season sporting events held on the Truman campus.
- Use of Natatorium during the time period designated for current and retired employees.
- Use of the Student Recreation Center and participation in ongoing programs.
- Eligibility for Designated Guest ID card program, in which eligible dependents receive an ID card granting privileges similar to retirees but on a more restricted basis.
- If under the age of 65, options for continued medical, dental, and vision through COBRA and conversion of life insurance to a “term” policy with the retiree paying the premium.

In addition, all may receive the *Truman Today* and *Truman Review*, along with relevant alumni and advancement contacts, on an individual basis via email or mailings, depending on preference. Updates for *Truman Today* should be made with the Office of Public Relations. Updates for the *Truman Review* and relevant alumni and advancement contact should be made with the Office of Advancement.

The President’s Office, in conjunction with the Office of Advancement, annually invites all local emeriti and retired staff to the Emeriti and Retired Staff Luncheon and the Faculty and Staff Holiday Open House hosted by the President. The President's Office also maintains mailing address databases for all emeriti faculty members and retired staff.
